In light of the recent [Disaster Proclamation](#) made by Governor Greg Abbot on March 13, 2020, regarding the COVID-19 pandemic, and the recent [Executive Order](#) issued on March 19, 2020; the City of Leonard has been and will continue to be proactive in its efforts to protect its most valuable resource – its citizens. We here at The City would like to inform you of the measures being taken to Promote and Protect the Health and Safety of our Community, and to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

The following indicate some of the action steps the City has implemented:

- Monitor the situation and correspond with Local, State and Federal authorities
- Implemented the City of Leonard Emergency Management Plan
- Public Library has been secured temporarily
- City Hall has been secured and remains operational by phone and email
- Water System remains secure and in operation
- Public Works remains in operation while maintaining Social Distancing
- Utility Billing is accessible [online](#) or Pay-by-Phone directly through City Hall
- Temporarily Suspended Late Fees and Disconnects for Nonpayment
- Credit Card fees have been temporarily waived and customers allowed to Pay-by-Phone
- Municipal Court is accessible [online](#) and by phone/email directly through City Hall
